Redflex Executes its Largest Contract in California and a new combination Speed and Red Light Enforcement Contract in Arizona

Redflex Traffic Systems Inc, a Scottsdale, Arizona based wholly owned subsidiary of Redflex Holdings Limited, is pleased to announce its contract executions with the City of Riverside, California and the Town of Prescott Valley, Arizona.

City of Riverside, California

The City of Riverside, California has a full-time population in excess 288,000, is the county seat of Riverside County (pop. 1.6 million), and is the largest city in one of the fastest growing metropolitan areas in the United States.

The contract with the City of Riverside is for up to 15 intersections and 30 red light enforcement systems for a term of five years plus two two-year extensions.

Redflex was awarded the contract in the City of Riverside as a result of a competitive bid process.

Prescott Valley, Arizona

The Town of Prescott Valley has a population of 25,000. This contract is for up to 12 combination speed and red light enforcement systems and speed enforcement systems for a term of five years plus two one-year extensions.
