**SETTLEMENT OF LEGAL ACTION AGAINST  
JEFFERSON PARISH, LOUISIANA  
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

The directors of Redflex Holdings Limited (**Company**) announce that a debt recovery legal action that the Company's subsidiary (Redflex Traffic Systems, Inc (**RTSI**)) filed against Jefferson Parish, Louisiana, United States of America, has been settled with Jefferson Parish prior to any Court determination of the issues in dispute.

In order to take effect, however, the settlement must first be approved by the 24th Judicial District Court for the Parish of Jefferson in the State of Louisiana.

Under the agreed written terms of the settlement RTSI is to be paid USD\$9 million. The Company is hopeful that Court approval will be obtained no later than 31 October 2015.
