Both cities will be implementing speed enforcement, and increasing our market presence with a total of 9 contracts across the State of Ohio.

Garfield Heights, Ohio

Garfield Heights, Ohio has a population of approximately 30,000. This photo enforcement programs calls for a comprehensive mix of fixed combination speed-red-light systems, fixed mid-block systems and mobile speed enforcement. The contract term is three years with up to two additional consecutive and automatic two-year periods.

Parma Heights, Ohio

Parma Heights, Ohio has a population of approximately 21,000. The contract scope includes the immediate deployment of mobile speed enforcement with the expansion to include both fixed and mobile systems based on the community’s public safety needs. The contract term is five years with up to two additional consecutive and automatic two-year periods.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, speeding is a factor in nearly one-third of fatal crashes in the U.S. In addition, more than 13,000 people die annually from speed-related accidents.

“The reported statistics on speed show that we have a serious problem on our roadways. The state of Ohio continues its commitment to speed enforcement and improving traffic safety for its citizens,” said Karen Finley, President and CEO of Redflex Traffic Systems, Inc.
