Two New Speed Enforcement Contracts – Globe, Arizona and Hamilton, Ohio

Speed Enforcement Growth Continues Across the U.S.

Redflex Traffic Systems Inc, a wholly owned subsidiary of Redflex Holdings Limited, is pleased to announce contract awards by Globe, Arizona and Hamilton, Ohio. Both cities will be implementing speed enforcement programs.

Globe, Arizona

With a commitment to maximizing public safety benefits, Globe's enforcement will focus on several intersecting U.S. Highways, including U.S. Highway 60 and U.S. Highway 70 that supports daily traffic volumes in excess of 40,000.

The photo red light and photo speed enforcement contract calls for implementation at up to 10 intersection approaches, stop signs or fixed locations and up to three mobile/portable speed enforcement units. The contract term is five years with up to two additional consecutive and automatic two-year periods.

Hamilton, Ohio

This community with a population in excess of 60,000 is situated directly between the metropolitan areas of Cincinnati and Dayton and will be the tenth contract in State of Ohio to implement a Redflex speed program.

This contract was secured resulting from a highly competitive tender process with a scope to include a comprehensive photo enforcement program.

The program is for five years with up to two additional consecutive two-year periods with a controlled roll-out. The immediate scope will focus solely on mobile speed enforcement.

"It is excellent that we are seeing speed enforcement growth continue across the U.S.," said Karen Finley, President and CEO of Redflex Traffic Systems, Inc. "These new partnerships in Arizona and Ohio exemplify how communities around the country are noting that speeding is a threat to public safety and that speed enforcement can do something to help remedy this problem."
